

MATERIALS LIST: NOVEMBER 2024

PAINT:

Best brands to buy are: Gamblin, Gamblin 1980, Williamsburg, Vasari or M. Graham.

MUST HAVE COLORS:

Bismuth Yellow *OR* Cad Lemon

Indian Yellow

Alizarin Crimson *OR* Quin Violet *OR* Quin Magenta

Naphthol Red *OR* Cad Red Light

Trans. Red iron Oxide (Williamsburg)

Titanium White (large tube)

Prussian Blue *OR* Thalo Blue green shade (Vasari)

Ultramarine Blue

Nice to have colors:

Kings Blue (Vasari).

Video Blue extra pale (Vasari)

Brilliant Yellow extra pale (Vasari). Ruby red (Vasari)

BRUSHES:

Silver Grand Prix brand (filbert sizes 4 & 6)

(flat sizes 4 & 6)

AND

Aspen Princeton brand (filbert sizes 2, 4, & 6).

(flat sizes 4, 6, & 8)

OR

Silver Bristlon brand (filbert sizes 4 & 6)

(flat sizes 4 & 6)

Bring any beat-up brushes you may have. They will make great scrub in brushes!

TURPENOID:

Get a big container as there is no shelf life to it and it's more economical when you get a big size. If you are a student new to oil painting, you can start with a small container and graduate to a larger size when ready for more.

TURPENOID CONTAINER:

I use the large size with three latch hooks at the top.

PALLET:

- Okay: 12x16 grey colored pad of pallet paper
- Better: the grey pad of pallet paper with a 12x16 plastic box (with lid)
- Best: the plastic box with a grey toned 12x16 piece of tempered glass. Stuart Art Store carries these products. This makes clean up MUCH easier!

LIQUIN:

A Windsor Newton product, get a small container because this product DOES have a shelf life. Used for glazing techniques and as a fast-drying medium.

CANVAS: One 12x16 panel and one pad of canvas sheets size 12x16

SHARPIE: Black fine point to label your chart

BLUE PAINTERS TAPE: One roll (Home Depot or any hardware store)

CLOVE OIL: One small bottle (this will help keep your paint wet longer.)

PHOTOS:

- Best: Your own photos
- Next best: someone else's photos (but you must have their permission)
- Very Best: Bring an iPad or tablet so I can share my photos in case you don't have any.

DO NOT bring any photos of other artist's work! We are **NOT** learning how to copy in my class. This is the most important tool we have.
