## Chris Kling Paint Your Loved Ones in Oil Supply List

## Winsor Newton Paint is preferred but any quality oil paint is fine:

Yellow Ochre or Gold Ochre(WN) Raw Sienna (Winsor Newton preferred) Venetian Red Burnt Sienna Burnt Umber Raw Umber Ivory Black Cadmium Yellow (Winsor Newton) or Cadmium Yellow Deep (Gamblin) Cadmium Scarlet or Cadmium Red Light Permanent Alizarin Crimson Ultramarine Blue Sap Green Viridian Titanium White

# Reference Photo: 8 x10 (must be that size) head and shoulders photo of one person you wish to paint. Not full figure.

**Medium:** Neo-Megilp by Gamblin, refined linseed oil, or Gamblin Solvent-Free Gel(or medium of choice). Plan on bringing two small empty lidded containers or jars for medium and solvent, respectively.

**Canvas:** 1 Stretched Linen Canvas 16 x 20 toned with a wash of mid-gray with acrylic paint ahead of class. You can tone with Neutral Gray N6" premixed acrylic. Or you may tone with a light wash of raw umber oil paint but it must be well dried a few days before bringing to class.

**Brushes:** hog bristle filbert shaped bristle brushes: #2, #4, #6, #8. Any brand of bristle is fine but the Silver Grand Prix 1003 is very nice. Also, if possible, a #16 or # 18 filbert bristle is wonderful for backgrounds.

Silver Renaissance 7110 Sable Cats Tongue Sable brushes #2, #4, #6, #8.

One round brush #1, Windsor Newton Series 7 in sable is good.

Sable Fan Brush or soft brush to soften edges and brushstrokes.

## Palette knife

### **Paper Towels**

Solvent: Gamsol

**Palette:** LARGE wooden or Masterson with glass or plexiglas insert, no paper palettes please (they absorb your oil)

Instructor will provide an 8 x 10 clear acrylic film already grided in 1" grid to place over the 8 x 10 photo each student brings.
