PAINT – Paint brand should be Gamblin 1980 or any **professional** grade paint

- **MUST HAVE COLORS:**

Cadmium Lemon

Indian yellow

Yellow Ochre

Cadmium Red Light

Alizarin or Magenta

Quinacradone Rust

(M. Graham Brand)

Prussian Blue

Ultramarine Blue

Titanium White

(A Large Tube)

- **Nice To Have Colors:**

Kings Blue

BRUSHES – I recommend the following for basic beginning.

Silver Grand Prix (filberts; size 2, 4, 6, and 8)

(flats; size 2, 4, 6, and 8)

Bring your old beat up brushes – they'll be good to block in your painting

TURPENOID – The more you buy, the cheaper it is. There is no shelf life on it so I recommend the half-gallon size to the gallon size.

Turpenoid Container:

Worst - Jar with a lid.

- Okay - Stuart Art Supply sells a jar with a coil inside specially made for solvents.
- Best - The metal containers that have a basket insert and a leak proof lid. I prefer the big one with 3 closing clamps at the top.

PALLET -

- Okay - 12 x 16 grey paper pallet pad
- Better - The grey pallet paper plus a plastic box with a lid. 12 x 16 in size.
- Best - The 12 x 16 plastic box with a grey backed piece of tempered glass. This will help you determine what value your paint mixes are. VERY IMPORTANT!!

LIQUIN – A Winsor & Newton product that is good for making paint flow, glazing and drying faster. Get a small jar as this **DOES** have a shelf life.

CANVAS – Start small. 8 x 10 to no larger than 16 x 20 to begin with.

CLOVE OIL – A few drops on a folded piece of paper towel (*that has been securely taped into the top of your palette box*) will help to keep your paint moist for 2 weeks or more.

PHOTOS -

- Best - Painting from your own photos
- Next Best - Painting from someone elses photos.
(*But you need their permission.*)
- DO NOT** bring in photos of other artists paintings!! We are not learning to COPY in my class.

Pampers Baby Wipes - For quick clean up

Single Edge razor blades - Bought in the paint section of any hardware store. Also a must have for easy clean up.

Paper Towels - Any brand you like.
